## Director's Report

2016 witnessed the retirement of Executive Director Terry Oldham and the arrival of Dr. Brett Knappe. Mr. Oldham led the museum for sixteen years and was honored with a gallery dedicated in the name of he and his wife Kay upon his retirement. Dr. Knappe is originally from the Seattle area, but had been living in Kansas since 1998. He obtained his Masters and Ph.D. in art history from the University of Kansas, then was hired by Baker University. He taught at Baker for eight years, attaining the title of Associate Professor, and receiving tenure. However, the challenges and opportunities of the Albrecht-Kemper Museum of Art convinced Dr. Knappe to leave behind the safety of tenure in order to continue the promotion of a wonderful permanent collection and insure the continued growth of the museum. Dr. Knappe arrived February 1.

## Events

The highlight of the year was the Golden Gala held on May 6 to celebrate the fiftieth anniversary of the opening of the museum. Patrons dressed for a formal evening in 1966, then enjoyed a night of dining, dancing, and even fireworks. It was certainly a night to remember. Old favorite events like Sugarplum, exhibition openings, and the Wine Walk thrived this year as well. In addition, the museum expanded its reach with a number of new events for a multitude of different groups. Children enjoyed the new Bunny Bash prior to Easter and their parents filled every seat for the first annual Witches Tea on Halloween. This year saw the addition of non-visual art events including music, theatre, and poetry reading. There were also trivia nights, wine tastings, and yoga. Private parties celebrated birthdays, anniversaries, bridal showers, and baby showers. Numerous local corporations held private events at the AKMA as well.



## What is New at the Museum?

As a mission-driven museum that continues to grow, the Albrecht-Kemper is constantly changing. In February, we initiated a new comprehensive recycling plan. In the spring, we introduced an ongoing series of Pop-Up exhibitions in which the work of a single artist or an artist group is placed in an unexpected location in the museum. In the first year, we staged Pop-Up exhibitions by Candace Castle, Armin Muhsam, Robin Van Hoozer, and the Fellowship of the Creative Spirit. Discovering these unexpected treasures was one of the great pleasures of visiting the museum this year. In the summer, we sponsored an internship for Missouri Western student MacKenzie Hardin, who began the long, arduous process of converting our files to digital format. In the fall, the museum became an official community partner of the Girl Scouts and soon after local troops started scheduling activities inside and outside of our classroom space. The Girl Scouts were not the only ones to benefit from a new education initiative either. An entirely new docent education program was launched that includes a series of monthly lectures by the Executive Director and peer to peer training as well. The new docent program helped the museum to bring new docents into the fold including Crickett Nickle, Vicky Barclay, and Christy Price. Two new programs that debuted this year were designed to get more of the museum's collection on view. The first is "Treasures from the Vault," in which a new work of art from the vault is displayed in the rotunda each month. The AKMA also prepared its first traveling exhibition in at least two decades. *Visions in Monochrome* was scheduled to open at the museum in November. That opening was delayed due to the fire and the full exhibition was rescheduled for November, 2017. However, a smaller version of the exhibition opened in early 2017 at the Kansas City Kansas Community College Gallery. This exhibition is also the first exhibition at the AKMA to be curated by Dr. Knappe. Finally, the AKMA captured the attention of our neighbors to the south. Articles about the museum appeared in *North* magazine and *KC Studio* magazine.

## Challenges

Early in the morning on November 13, a small electrical fire ignited in the loading dock. Thankfully, our security system detected the smoke quickly and Dr. Knappe arrived at the museum in less than fifteen minutes to let the fire department into the loading dock. Although there was no permanent damage, smoke had infiltrated the entire building, which required a massive professional cleaning effort including the cleaning of both the building and the art collection. The other challenge this year was maintenance and repairs. With an aging museum and Carriage House, repairs are to be expected and this year was no exception. The museum worked with local companies on repair projects including roof work, heating and cooling issues, kitchen appliance repairs, security system enhancements, a new loading dock door, sewage pump work, parking lot drainage, and the Carriage House boiler.

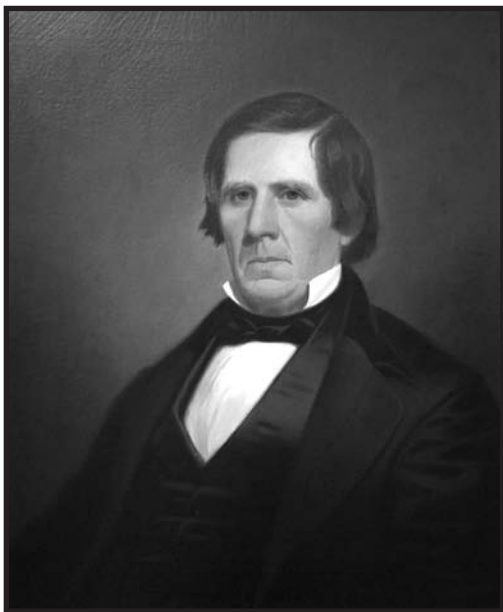
## What Can You Look Forward To In 2017?

With the arrival of Jason Thomas and his team, the AKMA Café expanded to three days of lunch service each week. Chef Jason is serving fresh, farm-to-table cuisine every Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 11am to 1:30pm. The Café is also available for group lunches, dinners, parties, and other events. The new year also brought a renewed Fellows program. AKMA Fellow is now a level of membership. There will be three or four special events for Fellows each year including a new party at the end of the year at which 10% of all Fellows membership dues will be used to purchase a work of art for the museum. If you are interested in learning more, please contact Jane Graves. On March 18 and 19, Randy Klein of Pen and Pencil Antiques will stage the AKMA Carriage House Estate and Collectibles Sale. We will sell numerous items that have been unused for years (nothing from our art collection!) and accept donations from the community as well. In the spring, there will be two new programs geared toward college students. On April 7, the first Juried Undergraduate Exhibition will open. Then, just two weeks later, undergraduates from across the nation will converge at the museum for the First Annual Undergraduate Art History Symposium that will be held in conjunction with Missouri Western State University. This summer, the Albrecht-Kemper will celebrate the total solar eclipse along with the rest of St. Joseph. We will stage a juried exhibition titled *Solar Flair: Celestial Bodies in Motion* and celebrate the event with a special brunch on August 20, the day before the actual eclipse. In addition, look for new artwork to enter the collection and grace our walls due to a generous new fund from the Kemper Foundation geared specifically toward the acquisition of American art.



## Acquisitions

The Albrecht-Kemper Museum of Art's Permanent Collection continues to dynamically expand. This year we received sixteen works of art and a large collection of decorative American silver. The Tinsman Silver Collection contains over 300 pieces of silver from the 18th, 19th, and 20th centuries. This generous gift included the donation of a display case and a storage case. The other sixteen works of art include a historical portrait by nationally-esteemed painter George Caleb Bingham; a unique double-sided portrait from the 1930s by Gertrude Freyman; a painting by 20th Century modernist master Albert Bloch; prints by Peter Hurd, Andrew Wyeth, and James Bama; and contemporary artworks by Jeff Robinson, Diane Marsh, Donna Bachmann, Eric Fuson, Brent Collins, Oded Halahmy, and Catherine Vesce. In total, these gifts are valued at nearly \$350,000.

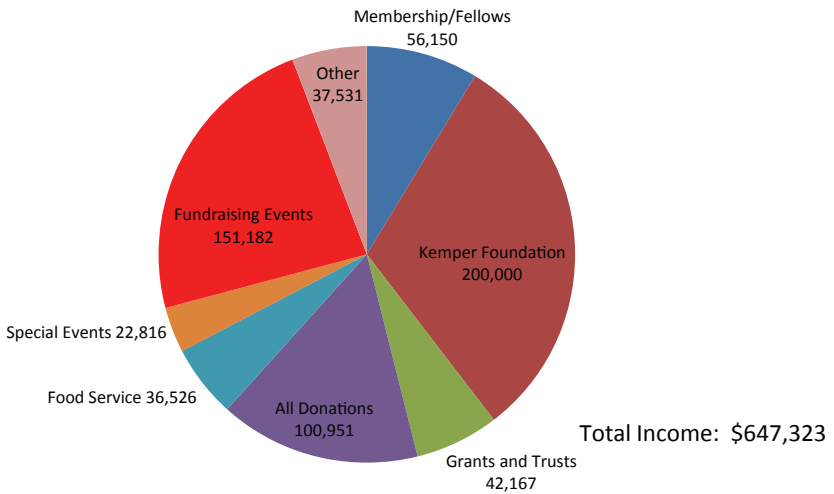
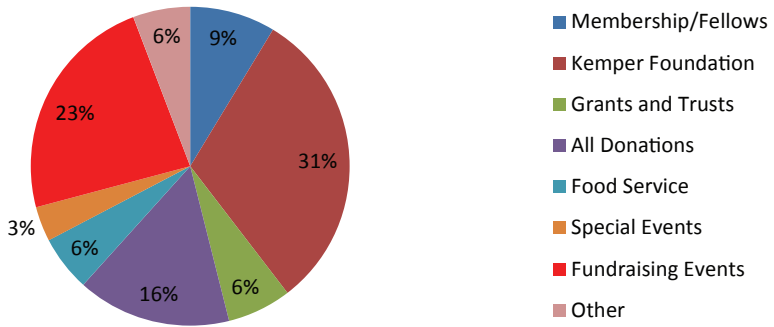
## Finances

2016 was a banner year for the AKMA from a financial standpoint. With income of over \$647,000, the museum bested last year's income by 29%. Since the museum does not receive any money from the city of St. Joseph or Buchanan County directly and less than \$10,000 in a 70/30 split grant for advertising from the Convention and Visitor's Bureau (which represents less than 1.5% of museum income), nearly all of the museum's support comes from the local and regional community. In fact, over 87% of all AKMA income comes from fundraising events, special events, donations, food service, and membership. So THANK YOU for your support. Without your help, we could not keep the doors open.

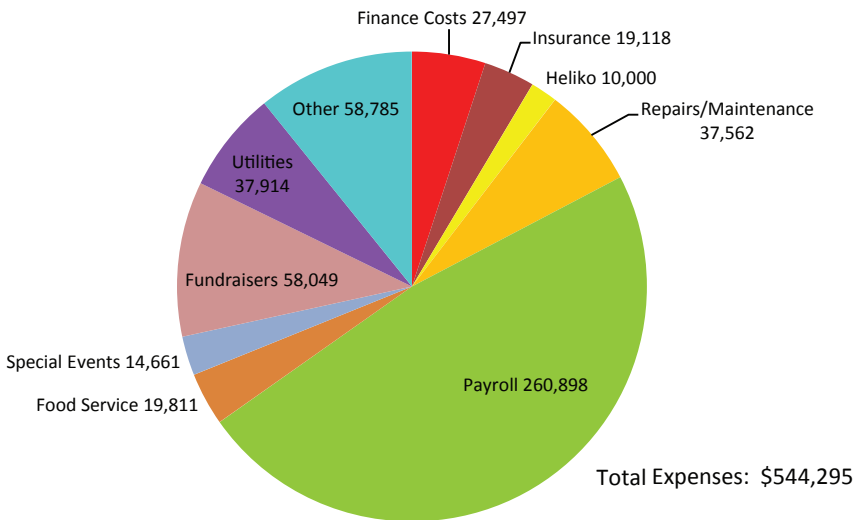
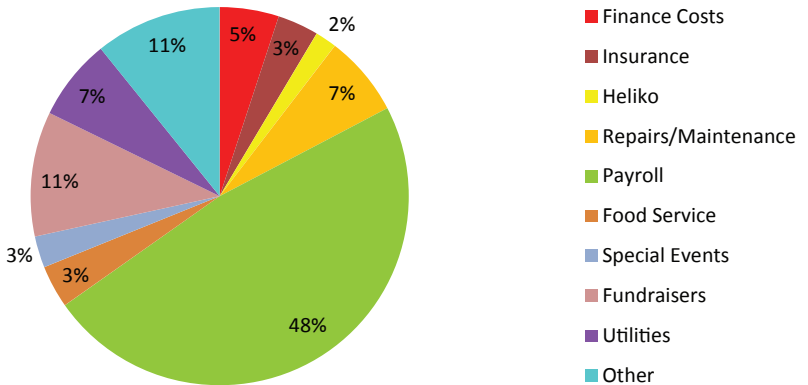

## AKMA 2016 Income



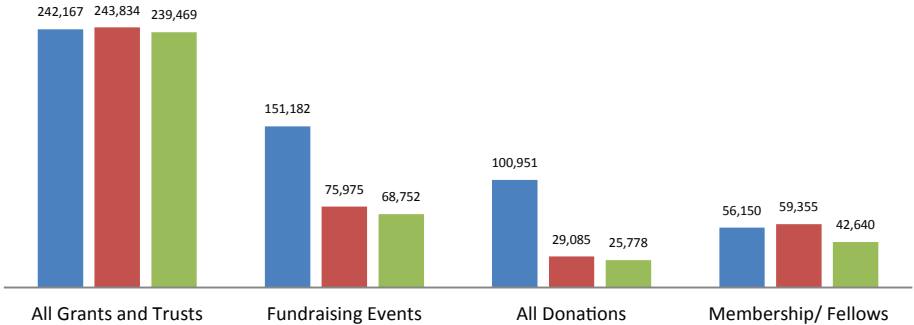


## AKMA 2016 Expenses



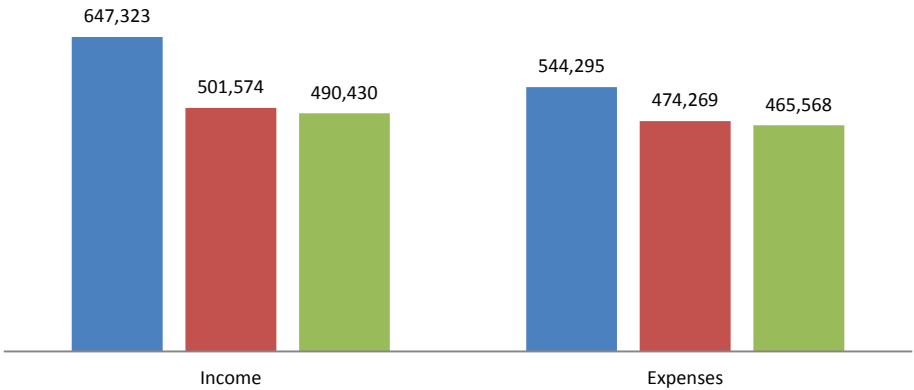
## Top Four Income Sources
