Director's Report

The pandemic has affected us all. This year started slowly but the sounds of laughter, conversation and even quiet contemplation found their way back to the museum. Pot of Gold, Witch's Tea, and Sugarplum returned giving us time to see our friends and reconnect.

Exhibitions and programs continued with full schedules despite trimming of budgets. Maintenance and upgrades to the HVAC started this year and will continue into next, which is a major step forward in caring for our collection. Planning began to develop the carriage house into an education center. This space will create more room for our growing classes, handling exhibitions and storage for the ever-expanding permanent collection.

Education

The Education Department served over 765 students this year, about 70% of them children. Art workshops for adults included many different mediums such as colored pencil, watercolor painting, oil painting, drawing, and pastel painting.

Over \$1000 in scholarships were given to children in 2021. T-Mobile sponsored our weekly Kids Media classes and free After Hours family events on a monthly basis. T-Mobile, Rotary, the Runcie Club, and private individuals sponsored Summer Camp this year. Camp was so popular it ran for an additional week. Various other summer classes were planned for younger audiences, including a sketchbook workshop and a puppet-making workshop.

We have been able to return to classes and artist demonstrations within the museum, but virtual participation continues to be available. Virtual tours and artist talks have continued into 2021, including the awards ceremonies for art exhibitions. The ceremonies can be found on our website and YouTube Channel. The Undergraduate Art History Symposium also went digital this past year opening it up to students from across the globe.

This year brought more classes and new experiences to the Education Department than ever before and I hope the momentum continues into 2022.

Education Statistics:

- Classroom attendance shows a 190% increase since 2020.
- Eight artists were employed to serve as teacher.
- 21 children attended weekly Kids Media Mix-up classes.
- 49 kids attended Summer Camp.
- Full scholarships were given to 12 kids for Summer Camp and Kids Media.
- Over \$4,000 was donated to the education department this year, sponsoring supplies and free art classes.



The AKMA added 40 artworks to its permanent collection in 2021.

The museum's collection of work by students of Thomas Hart Benton received a major boost with two donations related to the work of James Britton Gantt. Gantt was a student at the Kansas City Art Institute in the 1930s, studying with Benton and Ross Braught. His daughter, Briane Lawler, generously gifted a collection of drawings of workers at North American Aviation during WWII along with prints from Gantt's contemporaries at KCAI like Janet Turner and Malcolm Arnett. Susan Moore donated a tempera painting by Gantt, 23rd Psalm, which shows the clear influence of Benton.

The American Academy of Arts and Letters selected the AKMA to receive a gift from their Purchase Program that purchases works of living American artists and donates them to museums. The museum received two oil paintings by Peter Charlap, a professor at Vassar College.

Robert Hower, a Texas-based artist, donated two prints. Three paintings by Kansas City artist Linister were donated by Yvonne Umland Jameson, and Jan Thielen gifted the museum a seascape by Alex Dzigurski, a Serbian immigrant best known for seascapes of his adopted home of California.

Works by local artists were also added to the collection this year. Myrna "Pud" Ransdell and her family donated an oil painting, and Jim Estes gifted a ceramic sculpture. Friends of John Gilgun donated two of his artworks in memory of his passing this year.




