EXHIBITION DETAILS

Mosaic Life Care and the Albrecht-Kemper Museum of Art invite artists who reside within 100 miles of St. Joseph, MO, to participate in the Mosaic Life Care Juried Exhibition (the "Exhibition"). Qualified artists selected for participation in the Exhibition shall have their artwork displayed at the Art Experience Galleries on April 10, 2023 and for approximately six months thereafter unless artwork is sold.

The theme for the April 2024 Exhibition will be:

1. Artist Choice

Each artist may submit an *unlimited* number of works for the \$30 entry fee.

SUMMARY OF ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To be considered eligible, each entry must include the following requirements:

- Signed Entry Form (if participant is under the age of 18, entry form must be signed by parent or legal guardian)
- A photo of each entered work (refer to Photos section below)
- Non-refundable entrance fee of \$30 per artist
- Completed w-9
- Please do not submit pieces that have been in a previous Mosaic Exhibition.

All entries must be submitted to the Albrecht-Kemper Museum of Art. Entries must include a photo of the artwork. Please include a photograph of each work separately, if entering more than one piece. Please avoid distracting backgrounds. Digital photo files must be in .jpg format and no larger than 1MB. Each file must be named with artist's name, entry number, title, medium, year of creation (for example: Conway_ Entry 1_Spirit of Missouri_oiloncanvas_2010.jpg). Digital photos may be submitted on a CD or via email. Although digital photo files of artwork are preferred, 4x6 (minimum size) printed photos will also be accepted if each photo is labeled on the back, with the artist's name, title, medium and dimensions, and year of creation. Photos and CDs will not be returned. You must follow this process to be eligible for the exhibition.

All entries must be received by 11:59p.m. CT on Friday, March 1, 2024

All entries must be original and the sole property of the artist for show or sale and may not contain copyrighted materials owned by others (including photographs, sculptures, paintings, or other works of art or images) without adequate permission.

Please do not submit pieces that have been in a previous Mosaic Exhibition.

Artwork in most media will be considered; however, due to the limitations of the venue, video and performance art cannot be accommodated.

Please no sawtooth hangers, slot hangers or glass with clips. Art must be framed in a standard frame with wire on the back, ready for hanging. Canvasses may not be framed if the canvas is wrapped around the edges, but still must have a wire for hanging.

Works on paper must be matted and framed under glass.

IMPORTANT:

All Selected Artwork MUST be labeled on the reverse (wall mounted) or bottom (sculpture/pottery) with the artist's name, title, medium, price and contact information.

Price: \$100 (or please use "NFS" if your piece is not for sale)

All Selected Artwork must arrive appropriately framed and/or mounted and ready for presentation or hanging.

ARTIST PROCEEDS

- Artists will include asking price for artwork displayed when submitting for review.
- Prices will be included on an informational tag placed on the wall or in the case next to each piece.
- Sponsor provides a place for artwork to be displayed, assists with sale of artwork, processes payments from the buyer to the Albrecht-Kemper Museum of Art, who will then pay the artist.
- If artwork is sold prior to the end of the gallery period (normally 6 months) then the artist will submit a comparable replacement piece.
- If artist does not have another piece to display, then another artist will be chosen to display their work at the discretion of the Art Committee.
- By participating in the MLC Art Experience Gallery, artist agrees to a commission of 30% of stated purchase price to the Albrecht-Kemper Museum of Art.

- All artists must provide a w-9 when entering.
- We now accept debit/credit card payment for art sales; your check for your portion of the sale will be issued from the Albrecht-Kemper Museum of Art.

Purpose of Form

An individual or entity (Form W-9 requester) who is required to file an information return with the IRS must obtain your correct taxpayer information return with the InS must obtain your correct taxpayer identification number (TIN) which may be your social security number (SSN), individual taxpayer identification number (TIN), adoption taxpayer identification number (ATIN), or employer identification number (EIN), to report on an information return the amount paid to you, or other amount reportable on an information return. Examples of information returns include, but are not limited to, the following.

• Form 1099-INT (interest earned or paid)

- funds)
- Form 1099-MISC (various types of income, prizes, awards, or gross proceeds)
- Form 1099-B (stock or mutual fund sales and certain other transactions by brokers)
- Form 1099-S (proceeds from real estate transactions)
- Form 1099-K (merchant card and third party network transactions)
- Form 1098 (home mortgage interest), 1098-E (student loan interest), 1098-T (tuition)
- Form 1099-C (canceled debt)
- Form 1099-A (acquisition or abandonment of secured property) Use Form W-9 only if you are a U.S. person (including a resident alien), to provide your correct TIN.

If you do not return Form W-9 to the requester with a TIN, you might be subject to backup withholding. See What is backup withholding.
